NFPA 921 2017 Edition - Update & Case study - Reducing Wildfire Arson in the Macarthur Zone

Michael Forbes, President of NSWAFI will give a presentation on the new edition of NFPA 921. This edition was released in March and is of major significance to the fire investigator. This new edition contains a number of important revisions and additions that fire investigators must understand as they perform their duties. This presentation will review the major changes to the document in the new edition. Michael is employed by Fire & Rescue NSW where he has been for the past 23 years, and holds the position as Team Leader Fire Investigations within the Fire Investigation and Research Unit. He is a Certified Fire Investigator with the IAAI and a Certified Fire & Explosion Investigator with NAFI.

The case study will look at the work the RFS has been doing to reduce arson in the Macarthur area on the outskirts of Sydney. Paul Sweeney has nearly 30 years service with the Rural Fire Service. He has now retired but is still an active volunteer fire investigator (Wildfire & Structural) with the RFS. Paul mentors new fire investigators.
