Electrical & Gas Safety Regulation in NSW A Fire Perspective

What happens when an electrical or gas device fails and causes a fire? Who regulates these devices when they cause a fire? What has to happen for a device to be recalled? It will also provide practitioners with information on what they can do to assist NSW Fair Trading in the regulation of unsafe products in NSW.

As a recall officer for NSW Fair Trading, he has managed voluntary electrical safety recalls & instigated mandatory recalls. He is a member of several Standards Australia electrical safety committees.
