Statement of Facts in Support of Election Law Complaint:

I am submitting this signed Election Law Complaint Form because I recently learned that Ruth Ward, NH State Senator, District 8, has not submitted the required campaign finance filings that were due on June 17, 2020.

I believe very strongly in the need for transparency when it comes to campaign financing. The voting public has a right to know and the elected officials and candidates have an obligation to disclose in a timely manner the source(s) of campaign funding. This is essential in order for the public to make informed voting decisions and in order for elected officials/candidates to maintain the public trust.

Although I am writing this as a private citizen, it should be noted that I serve on the Grantham Democratic Town Committee as Treasurer. In that capacity, I am required to submit timely Reports of Receipts and Expenditures for Political Committees to the Secretary of State's Office. I submit these reports conscientiously and as required. It should not then come as a surprise that I should expect elected officials to fulfill their campaign financing reporting obligations.
