The Finger Lakes are a group of 11 glacially formed lakes that are among the deepest in the United States. Our excursion will take us for a two hour lunch cruise along Skaneateles Lake which is the highest and cleanest lake of the group. The lake is approximately 17 miles long by $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile wide with a maximum depth of 315 feet.

Mid-Lakes Navigation will be providing the cruise aboard the Judge Ben Wiles and lunch will be catered by Dinosaur Bar-B-Que.
