Regular interactions with stakeholders: World Bank Country Office, Road Sector Development Team (RSDT)



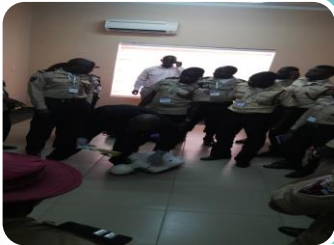
Follow up meeting of World Bank Country Capacity Team with FRSC and RSDT held at FRSC Conference Room on Mon. 22 Sept. 14
