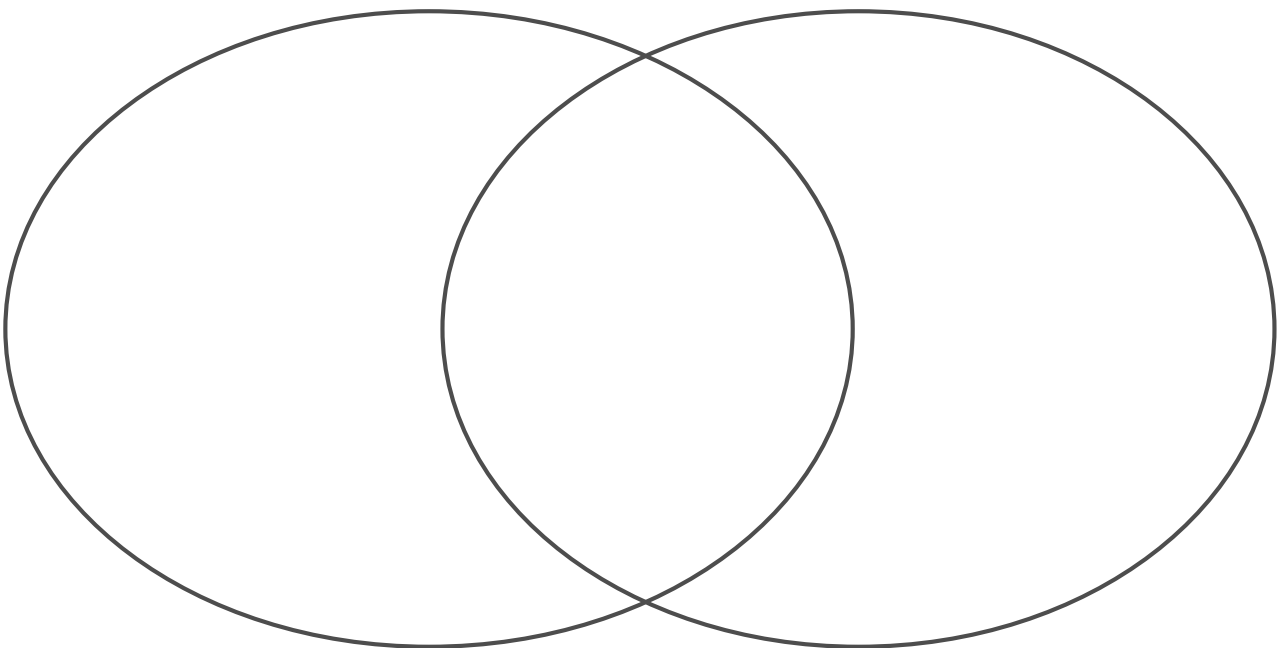

STATION THREE: SIX WORD STORIES

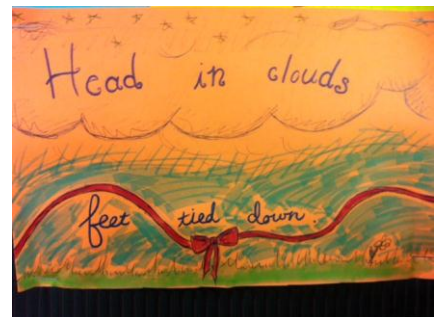
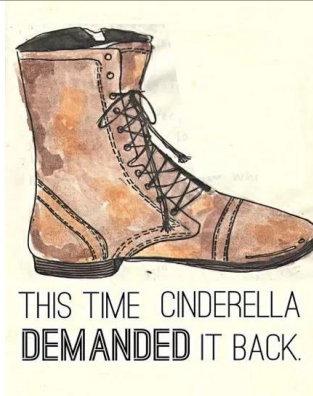
INSTRUCTIONS

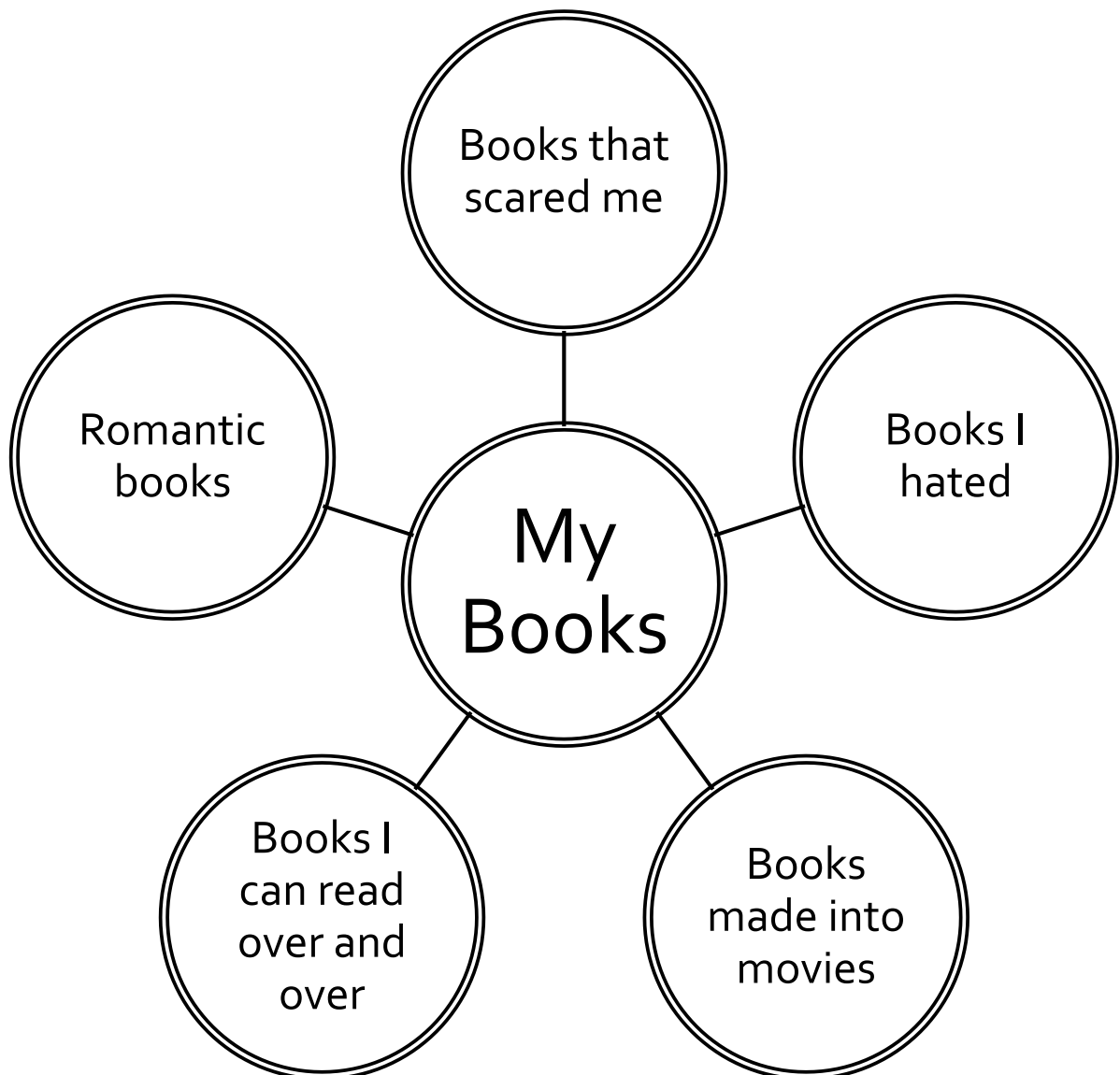
