## School Hours

The school day begins at 7:50 a.m. and ends at 2:35 p.m. Students should not arrive at school before 7:25 a.m. There is no supervision before this time.

## Carpool Procedures

When you drop off your children in the mornings, stay in lane by curb. Only let children off at the front entrance. **DO NOT BLOCK THE DRIVEWAY.** If you need to come into the building, you must park in designated parking places.

Carpool students are to be picked up between 2:35 p.m. and 2:45 p.m. daily. Car Riders will walk out to the front of the building when the bell rings and sit down behind the columns. Adults will escort children to the cars as cars pull up to loading area. (No one is to run to cars or cross the street to go to cars.)

## Safety for Walkers

Students are to cross the streets at intersections only: Walk across the street. When there are no sidewalks, students are to walk along the left side of the street facing traffic. Children and parents should plan the safest and shortest route to school.
