Event Information and Guidelines

- **Art/Craft/Gallery Vendors Tents:**
 - 10'x10' or smaller spaces will be available. You will be given your space location when you arrive to setup. Tents are only needed at the Outer Banks Brewing Station. Dowdy Park vendors will be in the pergolas.
 - You are responsible to provide your own setup. Please be aware that space is limited and you must bring all of your own setup.
 - Display racks cannot exceed 8' in height
 - Electricity will be available at DCAC and Dowdy Park, but not at the Outer Banks Brewing Station
 - Please bring your own lighting for your table- battery or solar powered preferred
 - Vendors are responsible for their own property during the event.
- **Set-Up/Tear-Down:**
 - You may set up your space beginning at 4:00pm before each screening, which all open at 6:30pm. You must remain fully available to attendees until the event is over. You may not breakdown during the films- it is disruptive.
 - Once you have unloaded your vehicle, please use a regular parking space near the venue
- **Guidelines & Information:**
 - Applications are due by July 1, 2019
 - Artists must only showcase surf/ocean/beach/water themed artwork
 - Each artist selling works must comply individually with all pertinent State of North Carolina sales tax (6.75%) regulations.
 - I understand that Dare County Arts Council reserves the right to select artists to participate in this art show and that Dare County Arts Council reserves the right to select which night I am a vendor.
 - DCAC will assign booth spaces and booth spaces will be numbered. All space assignments are final.
 - Use of space is restricted to the artist whose name appears on the registration form. Subletting, selling or giving of space to anyone is not allowed. Any breach of this rule forfeits the rights of the artist.
 - You agree to have a show and sell booth at the Surfalorus Film Festival
 - The event is a fun AND educational arts festival. Artists are encouraged to bring their creative materials and make surf art during the event – everyone benefits from seeing the creative process.
 - Artists accepted for the Festival should confirm their booth space assignments no later than Tuesday, September 3rd by 5pm with Dare County Arts Council. All decisions of the Surfalorus Film Festival committee will be final.
 - In the case of inclement weather, the events at the Outer Banks Brewing Station and Dowdy Park may be moved inside to the Dare County Arts Council. If this happens, will need to set-up in a much smaller area.



Registration is a commitment to participate in Surfalorus. No refunds will be made for cancellations, for inclement weather, or other acts of nature. I acknowledge that I have read the Rules and Standards on page 2, and I agree to abide by these rules established by Dare County Arts Council. I further acknowledge that neither Dare County Arts Council, Dowdy Park (Town of Nags Head), the Outer Banks Brewing Station, nor any of their agents will be responsible for any injury that may arise to exhibitors or guests, nor for loss or damage to any property for any cause whatsoever during the festival.
