Event Information and Guidelines

Art/Craft/Gallery Vendors Tents:

- 10'x10' spaces will be available. You will be given a layout prior to the event, with your assigned space.
- Vendors are responsible to provide their own tent, weights, equipment & must be strong enough to withstand wind and crowds ****IMPORTANT: Dowdy Park does not allow anything to be dug into the ground, such as spikes or tent stakes****
- Display racks cannot exceed 8' in height
- Electricity or water will not be available
- Vendors are responsible for their own property

Setup/Tear Down:

- Artists may set up their space beginning at 7:00 am on May 13 and must remain fully available to attendees until the close of Artrageous at 3pm. For additional sales opportunities, artists have the option of keeping their booth open until the close of the evening concert at 8pm. *Artists booths choosing to remain open until 8pm will receive premiere placement.*
- Once artists have unloaded their vehicle, that vehicle must be moved to the authorized parking area. There will be a designated unloading area. If you have an official state issued handicap license and would like to request special parking privileges, please make this known in your application.
- Artists choosing to close their booth at 3pm must have their tent broken down by 4pm to allow for the evening concert to easily begin.

Guidelines & Information:

- Applications are due by March 15, 2017.
- Each artist must comply individually with all pertinent State of North Carolina sales tax (6.75%) regulations.
- DCAC will assign booth spaces, and booth spaces will be numbered. All space assignments are final.
- Use of space is restricted to the artist whose name appears on the registration form. Subletting, selling or giving of space to anyone is not allowed.
- The event is a fun AND educational arts festival, artists are encouraged to bring their creative materials and make art while at their booth – everyone benefits from seeing the creative process.
- Artists accepted for the Festival should confirm their booth space assignments no later than Monday, May 1st by 5pm with Dare County Arts Council. All decisions of the Artrageous Art Festival Committee will be final.
- A welcome packet with booth assignments will be made available to all accepted artists prior to the event.

Registration is a commitment to participate in the Dowdy Park Grand Opening. No refunds will be made for cancellations, for inclement weather, or other acts of nature. The rain date is Saturday, June 3, 2017. I acknowledge that I have read the Rules and Standards on page 2, and I agree to abide by these rules established by Dare County Arts Council. I further acknowledge that neither Dare County Arts Council, the Town of Nags Head, nor any of their agents will be responsible for any injury that may arise to exhibitors or guests, nor for loss or damage to any property for any cause whatsoever during the festival.
