

SPEYSIDE

Glenfiddich 3.20

“Largest selling malt whisky in the world.” A fantastic beginner’s malt - golden coloured with sweet, and fruity notes giving way to a long and smooth finish.

Balvenie Doublewood 3.80

“A rich and sweet perfect after-dinner malt.” After an oak cask, a second maturation in a sherry cask gives this malt extra complexity and richness.

Singleton of Dufftown 3.80

“Singleton’s signature release.” A combination of ex-sherry and ex-bourbon casks create a fruity and nutty whisky, finishing gently with marzipan and baked fruits.

LOWLAND

Glenkinchie 3.80

“A great expression of Lowland style.” Located less than an hours drive north of The Red Lion, a lightly coloured malt gives a smooth and delicate flavour.

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MALT WHISKY & GINS



With five whisky regions in Scotland, and 'Mother's ruin' having a notable resurgence in recent years, The Red Lion offers a superb range malts of various styles and Scottish artisan gins infused with some wonderful natural botanicals.

All our whiskies and gins are served in a generous 35ml measure.



GINS

From its earliest origins in the Middle Ages, gin has evolved from a herbal medicine. The name gin is a shortened form of the older English word genever, related to the French word genièvre and the Dutch word jenever. All ultimately derive from juniperus, the Latin for juniper.



Edinburgh Gin 3.00

Distilled with fantastically fresh juniper, coriander, citrus peel and orris root, then mix in heather and milk thistle for that piece of extra magic.

NB Gin 3.50

Uncompromised grain spirit from North Berwick of 42 percent ABV, the result of an exacting process that's been perfected and bottled, to become recognised as the best London Dry Gin in the world.

Eden Mill Original 3.00

Made from Fife's seabuckthorn berries, a super food that grows within walking distance of our St Andrews distillery.

Botanist 3.50

22 hand-foraged Islay botanicals delicately augment nine berries, barks, seeds and peels during an achingly slow distillation.

Hendricks 3.30

Eleven botanicals combined in symphonic sublimity to tickle our sensory geisthavens each time we drink Hendrick's Gin. Distilled in Girvan in minuscule batches of 500 litres, giving the master distiller even greater control of her careful artistry.



MALT WHISKY

The art of whisky distilling has been perfected in Scotland for generations. Distillers take pure water from Scotland's crystal-clear streams and plump, golden barley from the fields and transform them into a precious spirit, which is then poured into oak casks and tucked away in warehouses to mature.



ISLAY & ISLAND MALTS

Laphroig 10 3.90

"Most richly flavoured whisky in Scotland." A full bodied and smoky seated whisky from Islay.

Bunnahabhain 12 3.80

"A good introductory Islay whisky." A sherry matured whisky, giving a little golden colour and a woody taste with a touch of smoke to it.

Jura 3.60

"From an intriguing isle populated by palm trees and more deer than people." A medium bodied whisky with a delicate, sweet palette. Aged in bourbon casks, Jura whiskies boast little smoke to their flavour.

Ledaig 4.20

malt barley is married with Mull's best dark loch waters in oak wood casks to create a floral and smoky malt with a touch of pepper.

Jura Superstition 3.80

"A lightly seated Jura dram." A smooth whisky combining the traditional Islay peated barley and a selection of aged malts.

HIGHLAND MALTS

Glenmorangie 3.50

"Vanilla & citrus." A good starter malt, this smooth whisky gives a fruity flavour with fennel and nutmeg coming through.

Macallan Gold 3.90

"Sweet with an oaky finish." A clear gold malt, years in sherry casks give a cinnamon flavour soothed by vanilla - youthful but classic!

Deanston 3.90

"Smooth and sweet." Distilled in Doune, this un-chill filtered whisky combines unseated malts from Angus and the Lothians to produce a light and nutty taste.

Dalmore 12 3.80

"A great winter malt." With a dark gold colour, this sheries whisky has a spicy citrus aroma that fades to a long spicy finish with hints of vanilla.

Dalmore 15 5.40

"Rich & spicy." 12's older brother, currants, cherries and nutmeg combine to create a marvellous whisky with a long finish. Definitely special!
