




Where the Fine Arts, Live Theater, Great Music, Fantastic Food and Friendly People Meet...

Encore Performing Arts Center, a non- profit 501(c)(3) will direct all theater operations and programming with the mission to:




Maintain this historic and irreplaceable community asset as a vibrant entertainment and education center through fiscal stability, programming excellence and strong community partnerships.
