Drainage problems

We are aware that there are some highways drains within the parish that are possibly blocked and when there is heavy rain this can cause flooding.

We are trying to compile a list of the locations of these drains so that this can be taken up with Cormac to try to resolve the issues.

If there are any in your area that you know of please send us a photo of the drain and the flooding being caused, showing the location of the drain in the street scene so the extent of the flooding can be seen.

Bus stop improvements

Cornwall Council's transport unit are working on the One Network project to improve public transport and links between the various transport methods.

The U1 bus route which runs through the parish will have some improvements made to it, namely the installation of a new bus shelter on the Devoran sliproad, together with solar powered display kiosks showing the live bus times at the two Forth Coth bus shelters in Carnon Downs. It is also hoped these will be able to be installed in Devoran as well but this is dependant on the mobile signal which the system uses being strong enough.

The Neighbourhood Development Plan is now undergoing examination by an Independent Examiner, once we have the Examiners feedback on the plan and on the comments from residents and other consultees, the plan will hopefully progress to the referendum stage towards the end of the year/early next year. Community Library

The Community Library in the entranceway to the Parish Office in Devoran is open every weekday (Mondays from 9am to 5.30pm and the rest of the week from 9am to 3pm). The Cornwall Council librarian, Chris, visits once a month to re-stock and deliver online orders, dates of his next visits is on our website. The Devoran bookswap has now been moved to the phonebox at the bottom of Market Street to make room for the library to be extended.



Planning

The Parish Council are a statutory consultee on planning applications. All current planning applications that the Council is being consulted on and will be discussed by the Planning Committee are listed on our website and displayed on our Facebook page. The agenda for the next Planning Committee meeting is also available to download from our website.

Community Defibrillators

Just a reminder that there are now three Community Defibrillators located as follows:

- On the outside wall of Ferris Garage, Feock
- In the phonebox at the bottom of Market Street in Devoran
- In the phonebox on Forth Coth in Carnon Downs



Training is **not** needed to use the defibrillators, the defibrillator will speak to you giving verbal instructions on how to proceed. In the event of someone suffering a cardiac arrest first **phone 999**, start performing CPR and ask someone to go and collect the defibrillator whilst you continue with CPR. **CPR is the most important part if someone has a cardiac arrest and shouldn't be stopped.**
