



Outline of the 3rd World Kyudo Taikai and 2018 International Kyudo Seminar

Date Monday 23, Tuesday 24 and Wednesday 25 April 2018

Venue All Nippon Kyudo Federation Chuo Dojo

Event Kinteki, Zasha, 36 cm diameter Kasumi-Mato

Categories Team and Individual

- Team... International competition, open to IKYF Member Nations, 1 team per nation
- Individual... 2 categories : Dan holders' category (Shodan and higher) and Shogo holders' category. Open to IKYF Member Nations and to the participants of the International Seminar.

Format

- 1) Team event (3 archers, 1 substitute, 1 manager)
 - ① Preliminaries... 12 arrows per team (4 arrows per archer), 2 rounds. The top 8 teams scoring the highest number of Tekichu advance to the finals.
 - ② Final... 12 arrows per team (4 arrows per archer), elimination tournament
 - ※ In case of ties during the preliminaries and finals, tied teams will shoot 3 additional arrows each (1 arrow per archer).
- 2) Individual event
 - ① Preliminaries... 4 arrows per archer, those scoring 3 or 4 hits advance to the finals.
 - ② Finals... Izume method
 - ※ From the 3rd round, 24 cm diameter Mato will be used.
 - ※ Apart from the 1st place, the rankings will be determined by the Enkin method.

Awards Awards will be given to the top 3 of the team event and of each category of the individual event.
