Next week, we will be holding Teacher / Whānau / Student Goal Setting Conferences.

The purpose of these conferences are for whānau to gain a clear, current picture of their child's achievement and for the teacher, whānau and student to co-construct learning goals for this term. These conferences will ensure that you, the whānau, are not only informed about your child's learning but you are also contributing to your child's next learning steps and supporting them to achieve them. These conferences differ from traditional 'parent interviews' as they are longer in duration and will form the basis of your child's Individual Learning Plan and achievement targets for the remainder of the term.

Dates and Times

Tuesday 30th July: 1.30pm – 8pm, **Wednesday 31st July and Thursday 1st August:** 3.30pm – 6pm. Each conference will be allocated a 30 minute time slot.
