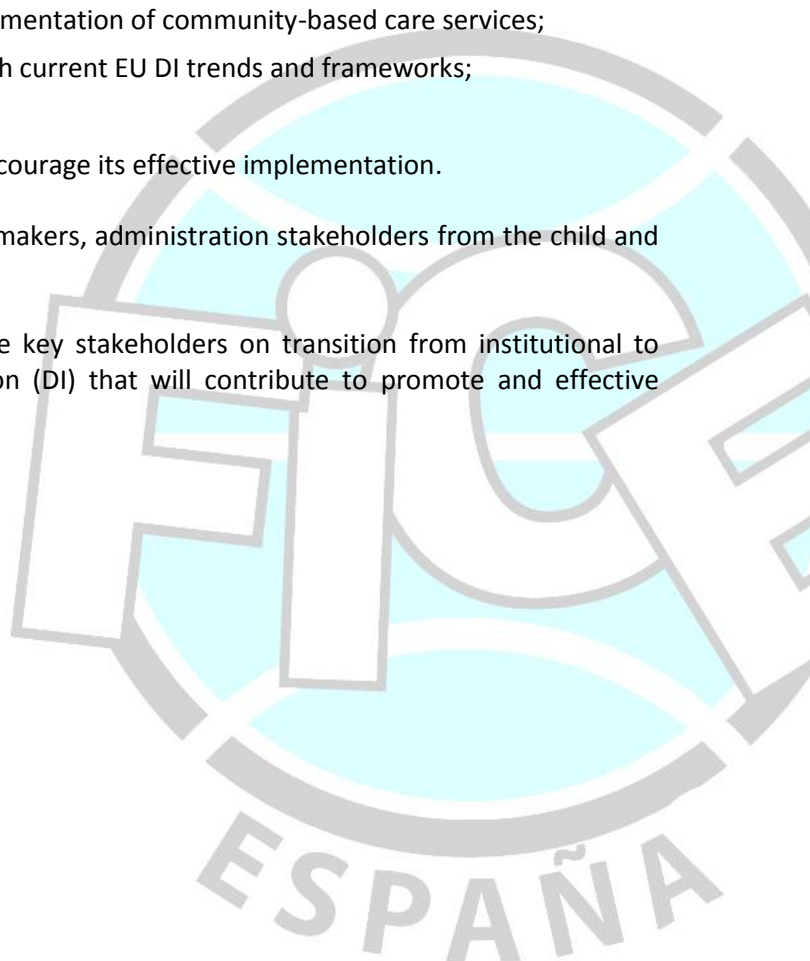
General Objective: To promote effective transition towards community-based services in children and youth care sector.

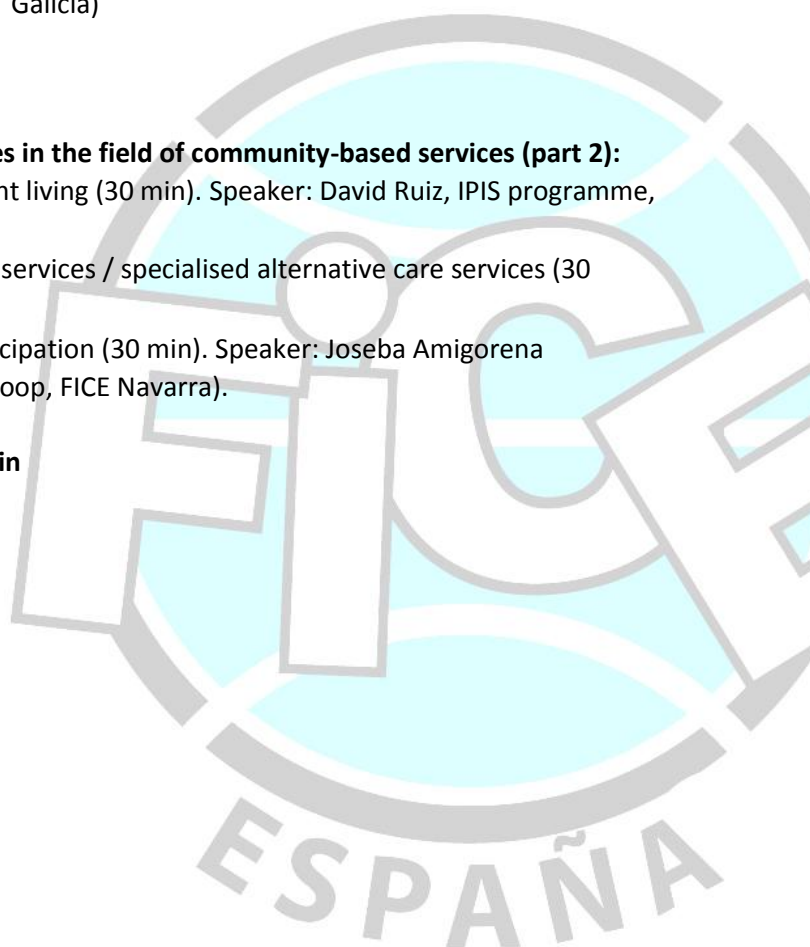
