NICE review of a treatment that may benefit a number of cancers

Jo Gumbs, National Director of OcuMelUK has brought this to our attention. NICE are currently reviewing a procedure which we wanted to share with you. Chemosaturation is a treatment used to treat tumours in the liver. We have studies showing its benefits in treating people with uveal melanoma, a type of ocular melanoma that spreads to the liver and we have now seen a study in Germany for another rare cancer.

The current review is looking at whether Chemosaturation should be an approved treatment for primary or metastatic cancer in the liver and so we wanted to let you know a consultation document has been issued and NICE require any feedback **by 5pm Thursday 23rd July**.
