London Community Response Funding Opportunity

A new wave of funding has been announced from the [London Community Response](#) – a [coalition of over 60 funders](#) who are working together to make it easier for charities to get the resources that they need during these unprecedented times.

Two tiers (small or large) of grants are available, there is no strict deadline but they expect to stop taking applications under this wave of funding by the end of July.

Lords Select Committee on Public Services submission

The Lords Select Committee on Public Services are running an inquiry into lessons from Coronavirus. Cancer52 has responded to the call for written evidence using information gained from our member survey to highlight the impact on charities and the positive ways our members have supported patients during the crisis.

New Covid-19 FAQs

Further to the government's new shielding guidance, published on 6th July, Bristol Myers Squibb shared an updated version of [COVID-19 FAQ document for cancer patient organisations](#).

This document supersedes the previous document (dated 10th June 2020) to account for the latest guidance relevant to cancer patients who have been advised to shield.
