## **Ruth Rendell Short Story Competition 2020**

## Terms and conditions of entry:

- 1. The length of each story must not exceed 1000 words.
- 2. Entrants can write in any genre.
- 3. Entrants can submit multiple stories.
- 4. Stories must be suitable to be read in the sensitive environment of a hospital setting.
- 5. The winner of the Ruth Rendell Short Story Competition will receive £1,000 and will be commissioned to write four further short stories for InterAct Stroke Support over the course of one year.
- 6. The closing date for all entries is 5pm, Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2019.
- 7. A £15.00 entry fee is applicable to each story entered. Payment can be made either by Paypal with email entries or by cheques made out to 'InterAct Stroke Support' with postal entries.
- 8. The competition is open to anyone, including non-UK applicants, over 16 years.
- 9. Stories must be entirely the work of the entrant and must never have been published, self-published, published on any website or public online forum or broadcast.
- 10. While the copyright of any story submitted to the Ruth Rendell Short Story Competition will remain with the author, stories are submitted with the understanding that InterAct has the right to copy, distribute and publish the story to support the charity's work.
