1. Circular Handstamp — various types, the earlier of which will also be found mounted up in their chronological position.
2. Endless roller type. Usually found on packets but occasionally on letters.
3. "Barred" type. Usually used for tightly rolled newspapers, also packets.
4. Electrical type. Slogan attached.

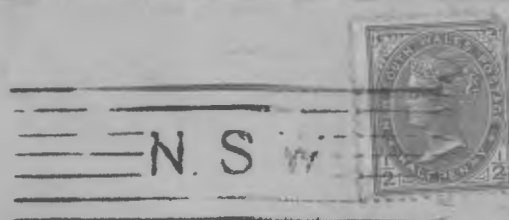
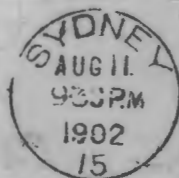

This new die of December 1934 was not in use for more than two months at the most and was then replaced by one slightly larger.

The frame now measures 21 mm across instead of 20 mm as previously and the length of the word PAID is 12 mm as against 11½ in the old die.
