09 Nights New Zealand Package Itinerary Auckland-Rotorua-Queenstown-Franz Josef-Christchurch Package

Auckland Hotel	VR Queens Street or similar
Day 1 10th May 2020	Arrive in Auckland.
	Upon arrival at the pick-up location be transferred to hotel for a check-in.
	Enjoy Dinner at a restaurant and enjoy the evening at leisure.
Auckland Hotel	VR Queens Street or similar
Day 2 11th May 2020	Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and embark on a half-day Auckland sights tour to explore the city's historic architecture and numerous waterfront spots, and soak in the atmosphere of this vibrant metropolis. After being picked up from the hotel situated in the inner city, ride up the palm tree-lined Queen Street and listen as the guide shares facts about the city's main commercial thoroughfare. Pass by the 19th- and 20th-century structures, including the Auckland Ferry Building and the old Auckland Customhouse and admire contemporary skyscrapers in the central business district. Later, visit the suburb of Ponsonby and learn about Auckland's thriving arts, nightlife and the culinary scene. Pass over the Harbour Bridge to North Shore and enjoy the relaxed vibe of the area, then stroll down Narrow Neck Beach in Devonport. Then climb the top of Mount Victoria and take in panoramic views over the city and the waters of Waitemata Harbour. Finish the tour with a stop at Westhaven Marina, the Southern Hemisphere's largest yacht marina.
	Have lunch at restaurant.
	After lunch, proceed further for Sky Tower Observation Admission Ticket and admire the city's key landmarks and the surrounding area from above.
	Have dinner at a restaurant and stay overnight in the city.

Day 3 12th May 2020	After breakfast at the hotel, check out and be transferred to Rotorua via Waitomo Caves. On the way take a 45-minute guided tour through the underground caverns and learn how stalactites, stalagmites and other limestone structures were formed over millions of years. The tour includes a boat ride through the Glow worm Grotto.

	Upon arrival at Rotorua, check in at the hotel and enjoy some leisure time and dinner at a restaurant; stay overnight at the hotel in Rotorua.

Day 4 13th May 2020	After enjoying your breakfast at the hotel., proceed to discover the secrets of the local agricultural industry in action at the Agrodome, a working organic farm. At Rainbow Springs Nature Park see New Zealand's fauna and flora on display. The tour is

Day 5 14th May 2020	After having a buffet breakfast at the hotel, check out and be transferred to the airport to fly to Queenstown
	Upon arrival check-in at the hotel and then be picked up for Skyline Gondola tour and Dinner in Stratosfare experience which takes place high above the town. Take a ride up the Skyline Gondola to the summit of Bob's Peak and enjoy a meal with a scenic view at the Stratosfarerestaurant.
	Stay overnight at the hotel in Queenstown
Queenstown Hotel	Double Tree by Hilton or similar
Day 6 15th May 2020	Have a buffet breakfast at the hotel and embark on a full-day Milford Sound Cruise. While on the cruise, experience the world-famous fjord in all its natural glory, and admire the surrounding rainforest, glacier-carved valleys and waterfalls.
	Leave Queenstown to travel through rugged mountain terrain, past Te Anau. Head through the Southern Alps along the Eglinton Valley, one of New Zealand's few glacier valleys accessible by road, take photos at the stunning Mirror Lakes, and travel through the Homer Tunnel, a 0.75-mile passageway drilled into solid rock. * At Milford Sound, board a ship to travel along the fjord out to the Tasman Sea, where native forests cling to steep cliffs, while seals, penguins and dolphins swim in the water. Along the way listen to the commentary of the captain.
	After the cruise, return to Queenstown by coach or choose to book a flight there.
	Have lunch, be transferred to the hotel and have a dinner at the restaurant enroute. Stay overnight at the hotel in Queenstown
