**SUPREME COURT (IMMEDIATE  
APPEAL) ACT 2018**

AC-2018-1

BE IT ENACTED THAT —

**1 Immediate appeal**

- (1) A party may appeal any judgement (regardless of whether the judgement is a judgement of the Court of Appeal) to the Supreme Court.
- (2) But there is no further right of appeal on a judgement of the Supreme Court on an appeal brought pursuant to subsection (1) or any other appeal.

**2 Permission required**

- (1) The permission of the Supreme Court is required before appealing a judgement under subsection (1).
- (2) The Supreme Court must not grant permission unless the relevant party can show that —
  - (a) they have a fair and just reason for requesting permission;
  - (b) granting permission will not unreasonably prejudice the rights of any other party.
