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#### INTRODUCTION

This version of the first volume is aimed at spelling arrangements, rather than phonetic ones. Only the main section and silent letters in the appendix, have been rearranged because of this.

Compounds already have a regular form at the start or end of the word and the rest of it will mostly be found in the first part of the book as single syllable words. Where there are subtle differences in spelling or pronunciation, these will be ignored as it would complicate the learning process (even regionally words and word groups are pronounced differently, so standard English isn't that standard).

While the sounds of a language may be constant, that doesn't mean the written word is equally regular. Sounds are arbitrary as are written symbols, when it comes to language and this can even more confusing where no habitual spelling pattern if followed. My layout exposes this problem of confounded expectation.

Note that lower case letters can vary enormously in form, even if most are still recognizably similar, whereas upper case designs are pretty invariable and instantly recognizable (a, g in particular stand out as do r, q and n, which look nothing like their upper case versions). Most are just smaller versions of the upper case letters, with variations in style in some cases (s, x, o). Others drop below the line (y, g, q) or stand out as taller forms than those around them (t, h, f, l, d, b).

Please note that the use of coloured type is to emphasize differences and to group similar material. This will be either in the form of whole words or parts of them, depending upon whether it's material in the main body of work or the compound / miscellaneous sections.

Repeat the words over and over again, until you can write them fluently: Remember that repetition breeds certainty. Write them until you're sure they look the same or at least similar to what you are seeing (recognizable): Close your eyes and try to memorize them.

If you're not good at writing (Can't control your hand movements well enough to shrink the letters down, to the small size on the paper) then write on a wall with a paint brush or use wallpaper, to practice large scale versions of what you see, using a felt tip pen or similar instrument. This will help you not only reproduce them but help them, through size, stick in your mind.

If the letters appear too subjective, then do drawings of their shapes and what they remind you of (S = snake / I or 1 = a flag pole / 2 = a swan etc.). This is helpful if you have problems with literacy or your first language doesn't use the English alphabet (Chinese, Arabic, Hindu etc.). Look for shapes in your environment that remind you of the letters, if nothing immediately springs to mind or find illustrated, junior spelling books that follow this logic.

Test your memory an hour after practice, by writing down the samples again and checking them out against the material you've just learnt from. Then do the same with this material a week, month, six months, a year later etc.

Get hold of word game books, like Word search etc. and look for words you recognize, hidden among them. Also look for them in newspapers, comics and any other written you can find, in the language you are learning. You can listen to English radio broadcasts and TV programs, to pick out words you've learned. Plus you can also check out words within words (e.g. pineapple – pine, apple, pin, in, app).

The first books in the series do not teach meaning but word forms. Your objective is to learn general spelling at this stage – later ones teach meaning and introduce grammar.
