


Project Scope Phase 1

Phase 1:

- WATER: Replacement of 2.7 miles of water pipeline, customer water service connections, water meters, hydrants and valves in the northwest quadrant of the downtown area.
- SEWER: Replacement of 1.7 miles of sewer pipeline and customer sewer laterals in the northwest quadrant of the downtown area.







Construction

- ► The locations for these replacements is in very discrete locations, primarily in residential alleys
- Schedule We will work with you! The goal is to be in and out as quickly as we can
- No work will occur on Thursdays near the Farmer's Market area
- Contractor is required to recess trench plates and clean the area
- Work in these areas will last several weeks due to restricted hours of work

Coordination Issues and Scheduling

- ► PROJECT SCHEDULE:
- Summer work limited to Francine Villas area
- ► Work in the Downtown area contractually limited to commence after Labor Day (September 5, 2016)
- ► Public Outreach has started. NV5 will be contacting Main Street Oceanside once the Contractor's initial schedule has been received (Due by June 15th to the City)

Coordination Issues and Scheduling

- ► Each business will be contacted to determine delivery times, hours of work, etc.
- ► Flyers to both physical address and property owner (to capture rentals and timeshare properties)
- Contractual provisions allowing City directed schedule changes to accommodate adjacent construction projects
- ► Contract Duration is 12 months with the goal to finish prior to Memorial Day 2017 (May 2, 2017)

Traffic Control

- ► Alley work will require a full closure and detour
- Trash bins will be coordinated to be collected at a different location
- ▶ Traffic area will be limited to one block at a time
- Contractor is responsible for preparing the Traffic Control Plans but all must be approved by the City

Benefits to Oceanside from Project

- Downtown waterlines will be more reliable and have a useful life of over 100 years
- Small sewer lines have prevented the lines from being cleaned and this project will allow routine cleaning and maintenance
- ► All 5 phases of the Downtown project will provide better flow qualities and increase the fire flow capabilities of the system
- As the downtown area is being revitalized above ground, our goal is to revitalized it below ground too!
