

INVITATION TO THE PEACEFUL MARCH FOR THE DRC IN ROME

The Congolese Catholic Chaplaincy in Rome, the Community of Priests and Religious in Rome, as well as Lay Associations of Congolese in Italy, in solidarity with their brothers and sisters in the DR Congo, with the support of Pope Francis through his many calls for peace and democracy in their country, challenged by the messages of the Bishops members of the Congolese Bishops' Conference (CENCO), echoing the call of the Lay Committee of Coordination of Kinshasa (CLC), invite you to the **peaceful march** they organize **on Sunday, February 11, 2018** to demand the full implementation of the December 31st, 2016 agreement, and democratic change of government.

The march will start from the Congolese Chaplaincy Church in Rome, Piazza di Pasquino, 2, near Piazza Navona, after the Holy Mass that will be celebrated at **9:00 am**. The final stage will be in St. Peter's Square with papal blessing at the Angelus. On the same occasion, a special collection will be organized for the victims of the repression of the two peaceful marches organized in Kinshasa and across the country.
