- Have a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Be currently enrolled in college courses (attach a valid class schedule as verification)

In addition to the attached application, the applicant should submit:

1. An official transcript (in a sealed envelope)
2. An autobiographical essay indicating academic and professional achievements, community service(s) 750-1,000 words.
3. A list of student's personal goals
4. A letter of recommendation from Chapter advisor or Faculty Member. **Letter MUST be on school letterhead and signed by the advisor or faculty member.**
5. Signed Photo Release form
