There are three ancient male models mentioned, starting at verse seventeen and going through the end of the chapter. These men are _____, ____, and _____. verse seventeen, "Yes, and if I (Paul) am being poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all." verse eighteen, "For the same reason you also be glad and rejoice with me." These verses describe the fact **Paul modeled** _____. He perceived himself to be the final element (i.e. drink offering) to another spiritual sacrifice from the congregation at Philippi. The next role model is Timothy. Timothy was one of Paul's converts, then his ministerial protégé, his faithful companion and assistant. verse nineteen, "But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged when I know your state." verse twenty, "For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state." verse twenty-one, "For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus." verse twenty-two, "But you know his proven character, that as a son with his father he served with me in the gospel."
