There are three main positions on the origins of life

- \_\_\_\_\_ creation (meaning God created all that exists from nothing)  
OCE's and YEC's fall into this category
- \_\_\_\_\_ evolution (also called Darwinian evolution or materialistic and or naturalistic evolution)  
Evolution (atheistic) = matter + evolutionary factors (chance + mutation + selection + isolation + death) + extremely long periods of time
- \_\_\_\_\_ evolution  
Evolution (theistic) = matter + evolutionary factors (chance + mutation + selection + isolation + death) + extremely long periods of time + \_\_\_\_\_

CREATION DAY ONE God created the **earth, space, time, and light verses three through five**

CREATION DAY TWO God created the \_\_\_\_\_

**verse six**, "Then God said, 'Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.'"

**verse seven**, "Thus God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament, and it was so."

**verse eight**, "And God called the firmament Heaven. So the **evening** and the **morning** were the second **day**."

Question: what were those waters that were said to be above the firmament? Some creationists believe that this was a protective water vapor canopy that covered the entire earth and remained there until the Genesis flood and then it completely collapsed. That idea is called the \_\_\_\_\_ but unfortunately that theory has problems.

Explanation:

CREATION DAY THREE God created the \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ (vegetation)

**verse nine**, "Then God said, 'Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear', and it was so."

**verse ten**, "And God called the dry land Earth, and the gathering together of the waters He called Seas. And God saw that it was good."

**verse eleven**, "Then God said, 'Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth' and it was so."

**verse twelve**, "And the earth brought forth grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and the tree that yields fruit, whose seed is in itself according to its kind. And God saw that it was good."

**verse thirteen**, "So the **evening** and the **morning** were the third **day**."

CREATION DAY FOUR God created \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_

**verse fourteen**, "Then God said, 'Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the **day** from the **night**, and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years;'"

**verse fifteen**, "'and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth'; and it was so."

**verse sixteen**, "Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the **day**, and the lesser light to rule the **night**. He made the stars also."

**verse seventeen**, "God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth."

**verse eighteen**, "and to rule over the **day** and over the **night**, and to divide the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good."

**verse nineteen**, "So the **evening** and the **morning** were the fourth **day**."

Reference: **Psalm 33:6** "By **the word of the Lord** the heavens were made and all the host of them (how) by the breath of His mouth."

Reference: **Psalm 8:3** and **4**

**verse three**, "When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon **and the stars**, which You have ordained,"

**verse four**, "**What is man that You are mindful of him**, and the son of man that You visit him?"
