Eligibility criteria

The video can be created individually or in teams and must only show video images that you have recorded yourself.

The video must be no longer than 60 seconds and in MP4 format.

Evaluation criteria

1. Respect the theme
2. Originality and creativity
3. Audio and visual quality of the presentation
