

ENOUGH – TOO – SO – SUCH

I. Enough:

S + be + Adj + enough (for somebody) + to V

Most of the students could do the test because it's easy.

*The test **was easy enough for most of the students to do it**.* _____

S + V + Adv + enough (for somebody) + to V

He played well and was recruited into the national team.

*He played **well enough to be recruited into the national team**.* _____

S + V + enough + N + to V

He was able to afford a house with a swimming pool.

*He had **enough money to buy a house with a swimming pool**.* _____

II. Too: [K-12 Notes] “too” luôn mang hàm ý phủ định (quá mức)

S + be + too + Adj (for somebody) + to V

The temperature is very hot. I can't bear it.

*The temperature **is too hot (for me) to bear it**.* _____

S + V + too + Adv (for somebody) + to V

The band played badly. No one wanted to stay and listen to them.

*The band **played too badly for anyone to stay and listen to them**.* _____

III. So:

S + be + so + Adj + that + S + V

The kid is very smart. He could solve these math problems.

*The kid is **so smart that he could solve these math problems**.* _____

S + V + so + Adv + that + S + V

My drink is very hot, so I can't drink it.

*My drink **is so hot that I can't drink it**.* _____

IV. Such:

S + be/V + such + (a/an) N + that S + V

The child is so naughty. He is often told off by his mother.

*He is **such a naughty child that he is often told off by his mother**.* _____

The weather was very bad. We couldn't go out at all.

*It was **such bad weather that we couldn't go out at all**.* _____
