

# ALTHOUGH - DESPITE

## I. Although/Though/Even though:

**Although/Though/Even though** is followed by a clause (Subject + Verb):

Example: He stayed up late **although** he was tired.

## II. In spite of/Despite

**In spite of/Despite** is followed by a Noun phrase or Ving:

Example:

He stayed up late **although** he was tired.

Despite *his tiredness, he stayed up late.* \_\_\_\_\_

Despite *being tired, he stayed up late.* \_\_\_\_\_

Jackie is a rich man, **but** he refused to pay for the meal.

In spite of *his richness, he refused to pay for the meal.* \_\_\_\_\_

In spite of *being rich, he refused to pay for the meal.* \_\_\_\_\_

**Although** he works as a doctor, his son dislikes the job.

Despite **HIS** *working as a doctor, his son dislikes the job.* [K-12 Notes] Vì hai vế khác nhau về Subject.
