## **ALTHOUGH - DESPITE**

## I. Although/Though/Even though:

*Although/Though/Even though* is followed by a clause (Subject + Verb):

Example: He stayed up late although he was tired.

## II. In spite of/Despite

In spite of/Despite is followed by a Noun phrase or Ving:

Example:
He stayed up late <b>although</b> he was tired.
Despite his tiredness, he stayed up late.
Despite being tired, he stayed up late
Jackie is a rich man, <b>but</b> he refused to pay for the meal.
In spite of his richness, he refused to pay for the meal
In spite of being rich, he refused to pay for the meal
Although he works as a doctor, his son dislikes the job.

Despite HIS working as a doctor, his son dislikes the job. [K-12 Notes] Vì hai vế khác nhau về Subject.
