

# PERFECT GERUND, PERFECT INFINITIVE & PERFECT PARTICIPLE

## I. Perfect gerund & Perfect infinitive:

- Perfect gerund is mainly used in reported speech, when the reported action is in the past, before it was reported.

*The suspicious guy was accused of **having stolen** the car.*

*The man was reported **to have been killed** during the accident.*

## II. Perfect Participle:

- Perfect Participle is used to combine two sentences if one action happened before another action.

***Having eaten** his dinner, he went to bed.*

*After **having done** his work, he went out with his friend.*
