Should, ought to and had better have the same meaning. They are used to say or ask what is the correct or best thing to do

	Should	Ought to	Had better
Affirmative	You <u>should study</u> harder.	You <u>ought to study</u> harder.	You <u>had better study</u> harder.
Negative	We <u>should not cheat</u> during exams.	We <u>ought not to cheat</u> during exams.	We <u>had better not cheat</u> during exams.
	should not = shouldn't	ought not = oughtn't	[K-12 Notes] Không có hadn't better.
