WORD FORM BASICS

A standard English sentence is constructed using phrases. Each phrase usually contains several words or smaller phrases.

The paramedics quickly took the severely injured people to a local hospital.

Noun phrase Verb phrase Noun phrase Noun phrase

I. Basic orders of words in phrases:

- Adjective goes in front of Noun: injured people, famous singers, friendly dog
- Adverb goes in front of Adjective: extremely smart, slightly higher, significantly strong
- Adverb USUALLY goes in front of Verb (sometimes behind): run quickly, carefully walk

II. More orders of words:

- Possessive Adjectives (his / her / our / my) + (Adv Adj) Noun: my (very lazy) student, his (famous) fried chicken
- Articles (a / an / the) + (Adv Adj) Noun: a (handsome) man, the (naughty) boys
- Prepositions (in / of / on ...)
 - o + (Adv Adj) Noun
 - + (Adv) V_{ing}
- Quantifiers (a few / a lot of / little ...) + (Adv Adj) Noun
- Linking Verbs (be, stay, get, seem, sound, smell, taste, ...) + Adj [K-12 Notes] Lưu ý mấy cái linking verbs này thường gặp

III. Advanced orders of words:

- Sometimes, there are more than one Adjective in front of a Noun: his old ceramic Chinese vase [K-12 Notes] Xem thêm bài viết Order of Adjectives (OSASCOMP)
- Sometimes, two nouns go together to form a <u>compound noun</u>: conservation area, convenience store, departure lounge

IV. Order of words in a sentence.

Identify parts of the sentence. Usually, a clause/sentence consists of Subject + Verb + Object/Complement. In each part of the sentence, the order of word is the same as in section I, II, III.

<u>E.a</u>: The tired students have patiently waited for the late bus for over an hour.

- 1. Xác định được loại từ rồi, cần phải xem xét về số nhiều/ít (Noun), -ed -ing -s/es (Verb), đồng nghĩa trái nghĩa (Adj Adv ...)
- 2. Trong tình huống bị khưng và không xác định được loại từ, khả năng cao sẽ cần **Adverb**.
