I. Functions:

Past Perfect can be used:

• To describe an action that happened **BEFORE** another action or a point of time in the past.

We <u>had finished</u> our work before we returned home.

They moved away after they <u>had sold</u> the house.

By the time we got to the theater, the play had already started.

By 1998, he <u>had travelled</u> to 102 countries.

<mark>That was the first time</mark> he <u>had been</u> to New York. [K-12 Notes] Phân biệt với Present Perfect.
