COMPARATIVES & SUPERLATIVES

I. Comparative:

S + V + Comparative ADJ/ADV ... + than + O/S+Aux

1. Short Adjectives: Adj + -er

Andrew is taller (tall) than Toby (<u>is</u>).

These boxes are bigger (big) those ones (<u>are</u>).

Building A is higher (high) than building B (<u>is</u>).

My shoes look cheaper (cheap) than his shoes (<u>do</u>).

2. 2-syllable Adjectives ending in -y: Adj + -er

The wealthy often live a happier (happy) life than the poor (do). Her dress seems prettier (pretty) than mine (does).

3. Long Adjectives or Adverbs ending in -ly: more/less + Adj/Adv

Lamborghini cars are more/less expensive (expensive) than BMWs (are). Bus drivers are often more/less careful (careful) than taxi drivers (are). Lan sings more beautifully (beautiful) than the other students (do). I walk more slowly (slow) than my father (does).

4. "much" and "far" as Adverbs:

We use "much" and "far" to signal that the difference is huge.

Maths is much harder than English.

They play badminton far better than I do.

Old people move much more slowly than the young.

II. Superlative:

S + V + the superlative ADJ/ADV + (Noun)

1. Short Adjectives:

She is the shortest (short) person in the class.

Summer used to be the hottest (hot) season of the year.

I think I have the slowest (slow) connection.

2. 2-syllable Adjectives ending in -y:

This girl is the friendliest (friendly) person I've ever met.

The pupperfish is the deadliest (deadly) fish in the terms of poison.

3. Long Adjectives or Adverbs ending in -ly:

This has to be the most boring (boring) movie ever.

I don't want to continue this book. It is the least interesting (interesting).

The most important (important) thing in studying is self-study in your free time.

III. Comparison of equality:

$$S + V + as + ADJ/ADV + as + Noun + (V)$$

He is as good as Mary. (good)

They play the piano as well as I do. (good)

She ran as fast as than him. (fast)

Their ticket is as cheap as a candy bar. (cheap)
