*******Classes are open to all breeds of horses and ponies. *******

Maiden Rider: A Maiden Rider has not won a blue ribbon in any previous show with the exception of Walk/Trot.

Walk/Trot: Walk/Trot riders may only enter Walk/Trot classes.

Attire: Show attire is optional; however, exhibitors are required to wear boots with flat or low heel. **Juniors are required to wear helmets in all Hunter classes;** recommended for adults as well.

Training Devices & Judging - Legal training devices are permitted in 'Green as Grass' classes; **if you use them in any other performance class your horse will not be placed over someone NOT using training devices.** If you do not want to be judged, please wear your number upside down.

Shavings: Absolutely NO shavings can be brought into this facility. One bag of shavings MUST be purchased for each horse stall.

Trophies & Ribbons: Prizes awarded to lead-line classes; ribbons for 1st thru 6th place in regular classes, trophies for Championship classes.

Move-in: Gates open on Saturday, May 12, at 6:00AM to facility. Gates are locked prior to this time. Practice and lunging must be done in Main Arena ONLY.

Important Health Requirements: A negative Coggins (within 12 months) and vaccinations for the Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (within 6 months) are required. You will be asked to show these records upon arrival.

Rules of Conduct

- * Safety is paramount. Children and pets must be supervised. All dogs must be on a leash.
- * Show management reserves the right to eject exhibitors from competition for excessive use of whip or spurs, or any other action(s) considered excessive by judge and/or show management.
- * Show management reserves the right to eject from the show grounds any exhibitor(s) and/or members of their party for unsafe or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- * Horses exhibiting unsafe behavior in the show ring will be excused by the judge.

We want our horses and riders to compete in a safe and fun learning environment.

Competition Rules

* We generally refer to the USEF competition rules as our guidelines, except where otherwise noted. "However, this is NOT a sanctioned event therefore the judge's and/ or show management's decision is final."
