

The ninth edition of the much-loved open exhibition. Following an open call for print-based artworks earlier this year, over 85 artists have been selected for the biennial Print International exhibition.

The £500 People's Choice prize will be awarded at the end of the exhibition following a public vote.

Alongside Print International, artist Pam Newall has collaborated with Tŷ Pawb and Oswestry's Designs in Mind to develop a live print studio in the gallery. Under the title Make Print, the studio creates print designs that feature on products such as cushions/toiletry bags and are sold through Designs in Mind's JOLT and Siop//Shop at Tŷ Pawb.

## Sean Edwards: Undo Things Done

We are delighted, as lead organisation for Wales in Venice 2019, to be bringing Sean Edwards' stunning and moving presentation from Venice Biennale back to Wales. Edwards' exhibition, a poetic inquiry into place, politics and class, intertwined with personal histories, is the artist's first major presentation at an international biennale.

'Undo Things Done' includes 'Refrain' a co-production with National Theatre Wales. The Venice Biennale is a prestigious, international event. Wales have had a presence at the Biennale since 2001. The exhibition is led by Tŷ Pawb with Bluecoat, Liverpool, commissioned by Arts Council Wales and supported by Art Fund and and Colwinston Charitable Trust.


