The programme emphasises skills and craft, working with emerging and established artists from all backgrounds.











PLAY-WORK


Until October 27 in Gallery 1

PLAY-WORK centres on an interactive playscape alongside celebratory documentation of radical play work at Wrexham's world-renowned (but lesser regionally known) adventure playgrounds since the 1970s.

Wrexham's three adventure playgrounds (The Venture, The Gwenfro Valley, and The Land) have been studied by play researchers from across the globe. Locally, the sites are an integral part of life for many families. Many of the current staff at these sites first encountered the playgrounds as children themselves.

The exhibition incorporates documentary archive and a live, 'loose parts' adventure playground designed by Wrexham Play Workers in partnership with Ludicology and artist Morag Colquhoun; including new experimental work by Morag and functional push cart artworks by Gareth Griffith. Additionally, the film 'The Voice of Children' by Turner Prize winning collective Assemble will be exhibited.

Print International 2019

November 16 - February 2 in Gallery 1 & 2

This edition of the biennial print extravaganza will show the best of printmaking in which traditional techniques are displayed alongside contemporary hybrid artworks. This juxtaposition highlights all that is relevant and important in printmaking today, continuing the ongoing debate of what printmaking is.

Entries for this exhibition have been received from 14 countries across three continents.

The exhibition also includes a live print studio project titled 'Make Print' by artist Pam Newall in collaboration with Designs in Mind and Regional Print Centre, plus 1970s archival material from the Bradford Biennial.


