This book reads as Helen Lederer talks - a mad tumble of words with acutely detailed descriptions, no holds barred. She says that everything she describes in Losing It - including the coffee colonics - are things she's personally experienced, so one can only wonder which callous magazine editor sent her to lose weight by taking a new diet pill! Her heroine, Millie, is an agony aunt who's in debt, divorced and desperate to earn money, lose weight and have a sex life. Millie's middle-aged dilemmas are those that many of us experience, although we may not take such drastic measures to resolve them. This is the perfect holiday read: funny, entertaining, but with a message of hope for those of us whose bodies are heading south.




