## Attendance Is So Important

We would like to remind all children and parents that attendance at school is very important.

Regular and punctual attendance of pupils at school is both a legal requirement and crucial to a pupil's success - there is a clear link between a high rate of attendance and high achievement. If pupils are not in lessons they **CANNOT LEARN! EVERY LESSON REALLY DOES COUNT!!** Statistics show missing 8.5 days of school in any school year can reduce the success level of a pupil by 25%.

Where a pupil's attendance is below 90%, it is the equivalent of missing 19 days of school = nearly 4 weeks or 95 lessons per year!

Attendance below 80% = 38 DAYS absence, nearly 8 WEEKS or 190 LESSONS per year!

## ATTENDANCE!!!




The school attendance for last week (week ending 15th September) was 98.3% This is 2.2% ABOVE the national expected target of 96.1%
