2017-2018 Pikes Peak USBC ANNUAL WOMEN'S CITY CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1 **ELIGIBILITY:** Tournament is open to all Female PPUSBC members. All participants must show a current USBC Membership Card at check-in. Non-USBC bowlers who reside within the Pikes Peak USBC area (El Paso and Teller counties) may qualify by paying the \$20.00 USBC Membership fee. Any USBC member who identifies him or herself as a "Professional" may participate. Professional bowlers will be limited to only one on any four-person team or Doubles team.
- 2 **MULTIPLE ENTRIES:** Bowlers may enter multiple Team events. No more than two bowlers may participate together on multiple teams. Multiple entries are allowed in Doubles with a different partner. Bowlers entering Doubles or Singles must enter both events. First score in each event will count towards All-Events. Individual bowlers may place only once in the top ten in Singles.
- 3 **DRESS CODE:** NO headgear, cutoffs, tank tops, muscle shirts, clothing with offensive language/pictures, or bare midriffs will be allowed. Shorts must be at least knee length. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and prizes. Tournament Manager shall have final say in compliance with dress code.
- 4 **AVERAGES:** Highest 2016-2017 average of 21 games or more will be used. If no 2016-2017 average, bowler may use a certified 2017 summer league average of 21 games or more (this average must be on file with the PPUSBC office). If a bowler has neither of the above average, they may use their highest current certified league average of 21 games or more as of November 6, 2017. If a bowler does not have any of the qualifying averages, they will be assigned a scratch average of 230. Bowlers who are required to use a current league average must show verification signed by their league secretary or produce a League Standing sheet showing their current average as of November 6 2017.
- 5 **AVERAGE VERIFICATION:** It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler, Team Captain, or someone else. Failure to use the proper average or make the correction prior to the end of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score bowled if the submitted average is lower than the proper average. If the submitted average is higher than the proper average, any final standings or monies won will be based on the submitted average. **USBC RULE 319 e 2, (10 pin rule) does not apply to this tournament. PLEASE SEE RULE 319c**
- 6 **HANDICAP:** Shall be based on 90% of 230. (Exp-Awards Luncheon/Winners provided lunch/Trophies/printing)
- 7 **ENTRY FEES:** Per Bowler - per event are Prize Fund -\$11.75, Lineage- \$8.25 Exp-\$5.00 for a total of \$25.00. ALL Bowlers that enter into the Scratch All- Events must also enter into the Handicapped All-Events. Entry fee for All-Events is \$5.00 for scratch and \$5.00 for handicap.
7a A late fee \$10 per bowler/event will be assessed for entries received after Nov. 6, 2017.deadline and reservations will only be allowed if space is available. Late entry fees will also apply to walk-in entries.
- 8 **PRIZE RATIO:** Shall be on a 1 in 5 basis. Awards shall be given to the winners of each event, ie: Team, Doubles, Singles and All-Events.
- 9 **NO REFUNDS:** No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund after definite dates and times have been assigned. Persons submitting entries and failing to receive written confirmation must contact the Tournament Office at 719-963-9656.
- 10 **LANE ASSIGNMENTS:** All lane assignments are to be made by the Tournament Manager.
If it becomes necessary to reschedule bowlers in any event, it will be done at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. In case of a machine failure and it becomes impossible to complete an event within the allotted time, the event will be rescheduled and bowling will resume at the point where it was discontinued.
- 11 **TEAM CAPTAIN:** Is responsible for the submission of each entry and all fees. The team captain is the team representative and will serve in all matters pertaining to individual behavior, and compliance with Tournament and USBC Rules.
- 12 **CHECK-IN TIMES:** All bowlers must check in at least 45 minutes prior to their scheduled squad starting times.
- 13 **TARDY BOWLERS:** Tardy bowlers will start in the frame being bowled when they are READY for tournament play and will receive no score for any frames missed. Teams refusing to start at the scheduled time shall forfeit their entry fee and will not be allowed to compete.
- 14 **SCORE SHEETS:** After a score sheet has been signed by a contestant or Team Captain, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Bowlers are cautioned to sign score sheet only after ensuring its accuracy. Computer printouts from the participating center will be the official score sheet in all cases. These will be kept on file for 10 days.
- 15 **PROTESTS:** Any protests pertaining to interpretation or application of tournament rules must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager, with a copy to USBC and filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

USBC rules and regulations will apply in all instances not specifically covered in the above rules as stated. The PPUSBC Tournament Manager will make rulings on all questions, disputes, and rules not covered by these tournament rules.
