

# Who's at the Table Developing the State Water Plan?



As the Water Planning Council (WPC) has been charged by Public Act 14-163 to develop a State Water Plan, a number of committees, with individuals with different backgrounds and perspectives have been established to support the effort. Steps are being taken to define the roles of the committees and ensure that their combined efforts contribute to development of a data-driven, balanced plan that reflects stakeholder input consistent with the law.
