RESPONSIBILITIES

- Understand contracts and technical data to monitor, improve and report progress to management
- Accountable for overall project quality while understanding and adhering to the schedule and budget
- Read and challenge Owners Engineers interventions log and Monthly Reports
- Check the EPC Contractors compliance with the Contractual expected quality plans, quality assurance
- Track complete overview of existing issues and their potential solutions for recommendations and effective resolution
- Overall responsibility to ensure HSE performance for the project and that contractors meet the required standards by carrying out inspections on site
- Corelate on ground project progress to aspects of budget and schedule for reporting
- Collaborate with engineers, trade workers and other construction specialists to find optimum solutions
- Manage contractor communication, timely receipt of delivery items and oversee subcontractor activities while providing interface for various other civil activities
- Respond to work delays, emergencies, and other ad-hoc problems
- Comply with legal requirements, safety codes and other regulations
- Keep a register of every actionable item to be handed over to the operations team at completion
- Approve changes in scope of work for contractors
- Document and verify the technical background for claims with contractors and the Project while maintaining a daily log of events for contractual discussions and disputes later
- Ensure contractors invoices are correct and deliverables received prior to payment with the use of Owners Engineer
- Provide inputs to the Project Services Manager and other stakeholders (Lender's Technical Advisor, Sponsors, Owner's Engineer) and the reports published for civil related topics
- Responsible for the civil milestones & civil project budget
- Approve revised reference plan, reported progress and civil project report monthly
- Provide updated key milestones on a monthly basis and a report on key events that affects the schedule
- Establish and implement risk monitoring, identifying, and escalating for the civil scope of the Project
- Evaluate the consequences of risks on cost and plan (consequence for activities)
- Agree on documentation filing procedures, delivery during handover, production monitoring including SCADA, IT requirements for the facility, creation of spare parts register, material lists with operations readiness teams
- Provide all documents required for governmental and invoice approvals
