4. If selected, list what educational or training program you would like to attend? Provide specific dates, location(s), and expenses.
5. List if you have demonstrated interest in community affairs or other extra-curricular activities.
6. Applicant must provide two recommendation letters; one must be from a supervisor, faculty member or other individual knowledgeable of applicant's qualifications. *Note: Family members are ineligible.*
7. The Scholarship Award is \$1000. The **application must be postmarked by April 6, 2018 or delivered to HCCI, Inc., C/o The Scholarship Fund, 256 West 153rd Street, by the close of business on Monday, April 6, 2018.**
