A NOTE FROM TANZIE

We at The Tanzie Project want to thank everyone who has kept our mission up, running, and growing for 3 years!! Thank you all so much from the “pawttom” of our hearts.

Tanzie here! Wow, I can't believe it's been another year of Bosnian rescue craziness! Without your generosity and help, we never would be able to rescue and rehome so many Bosnian strays.

In fact, thanks to you, we raised more than \$64,000 in 2018 to support Bosnian strays! Your 2018 donations helped transport 59 former Bosnian street dogs to new families across the globe: 26 to Austria, 8 to the UK, 14 to the USA, 2 to Germany, 5 to Denmark, 2 to Hungary, and 2 to Canada -- our very first Bosnian-Canadian pups!

We also covered nearly \$8,500 in veterinary expenses,

including surgeries, medications, vaccinations, and transport paperwork. This included medication for Birdie and Ghandi's skin condition, Djecak's wheelchair reconstruction (still underway), Dingo's tumor removal, Keza's surprise “puppy shower” (i.e., puppy vaccinations), and regular vetting expenses.

Additionally, your donations helped to purchase \$6,570 in dog food, which fed 54 shelter dogs for the entire year!



FINANCIALS

We launched our first fundraiser benefiting Bosnia's stray dogs in December 2014, when founder Katie asked her friends for \$500 to buy dog food - and the rest is history! It's amazing what we can all achieve when we come together for the common good!

To showcase our overall growth, we've also included 2015-2017 financial figures in this summary. Wow, we have made a huge impact since that first fundraiser more than four years ago!

TTP's two program areas are Animal Rescue and Animal Welfare. Animal Rescue entails travel and transport expenses, and Animal Welfare includes veterinary expenses, food, shelter repairs and construction, and shelter fees.

TRANSPORTS: Expenses incurred relating to animal transport, including animal airfare, ground transport services, passports, health certificates, travel supplies (leashes, harnesses, etc).

FOOD: Costs of dog food for animals at rescue partners' shelter or other private pensions. This

includes food revenues and expenses directly related to the Fairy Dog Parent program.

VETERINARY CARE: Includes both surgical and non-surgical expenses; whether for significant treatment or repair due to injury or illness; or routine vaccinations, medications, or treatments other than surgical.

SHELTER FEES & REPAIRS: All expenses related to operation and maintenance of rescue partners' shelters, or fees paid to private shelters (pensions). This also includes construction or improvement of facilities, and payment to shelter workers.


OTHER ANIMAL WELFARE COSTS: Includes expenses for animal supplies not related to food, veterinary, or transport expenses (potty pads, blankets, etc).

ADMIN EXPENSES: Costs of various administrative expenses, including payment processing fees (PayPal, Western Union, Stripe, WePay); bank fees including transfer and currency exchange fees; monthly software subscription services (accounting, marketing, shelter database); annual website subscription and hosting; postage; phone; and related expenses.





Face of Defense: Airman Finds Hope, Purpose During Deployment

JOINT BASE LANGLEY-EUSTIS, Va. -- Experiences during a 2014 deployment to Bosnia and Herzegovina for the media operations noncommissioned officer in charge of the 633rd Air Base Wing's public affairs office here led her to establish what now is a thriving nonprofit organization.



When Air Force Tech. Sgt. Katie Ward received her orders to deploy to Sarajevo, Ward said she had to look it up on a map. Although this would be her first deployment, her husband, Walker Ward, had served an eight-month tour in Iraq in 2010, so she was familiar with the logistics, she said.

The Bosnian war in the mid-1990s had left more than 100,000 people dead and 2 million displaced. What did you do as a journalist at NATO camp outside Sarajevo in 2014. Katie Gar Ward (of '08) was overwhelmed by the masses of dogs roaming the streets. One particular story that hung about the camp for weeks led her to help Ward to begin a nonprofit upon her return to the United States. Through The Tanzie Project, Ward now finds families to adopt or foster the street dogs of Bosnia, and Herzegovina. She partners with local rescue groups in the effort, which open and create to help them the population. Donations to The Tanzie Project cover rehabilitation, shelter and transportation costs. More than 200 dogs have been adopted or fostered in Europe and the US. "She's not just a dog that she was and decided to help," said Bosnian rescue Felicia Duhaj, in an email. Ward grew up in Charlottesville and the family of her high school, partly, she says. As an adult, she adopted shelter dogs but never planned on leading an international group to help them. That changed when she met one her media with dogs like a solution that she named "Tanzie." "There was just something about her eyes," Ward says. "Tanzie now lives with Ward and her husband in Henric, Virginia, where Ward continues her work at Joint Base Langley-Eustis as a publicist in public affairs. Because of her love of Tanzie, Ward says she's including her new work as an advocate for animals. "I will never not want to help dogs," —Dorota Wlasczyn


Bobby - Ireland


