

# CSLA, Waves Reach Finals; Lewis Hits 46

It will be Raymond Lewis and Cal State Los Angeles against William Averitt and Pepperdine in the championship game of the Cal St. LA basketball tournament Saturday night.

Averitt scored 25 points and freshman Dick Skophammer got 22, including the winning basket with one second left, as Pepperdine downed Grambling, 72-70, in the opener of the first-round doubleheader Thursday night at the Sports Arena.

In the nightcap, Lewis scored a school record 46 points, hitting 18 of 31 from the floor, as the Diablos defeated Texas Southern, 103-98. Lewis' performance broke the record of 43, set by Ron Knight in 1969.
