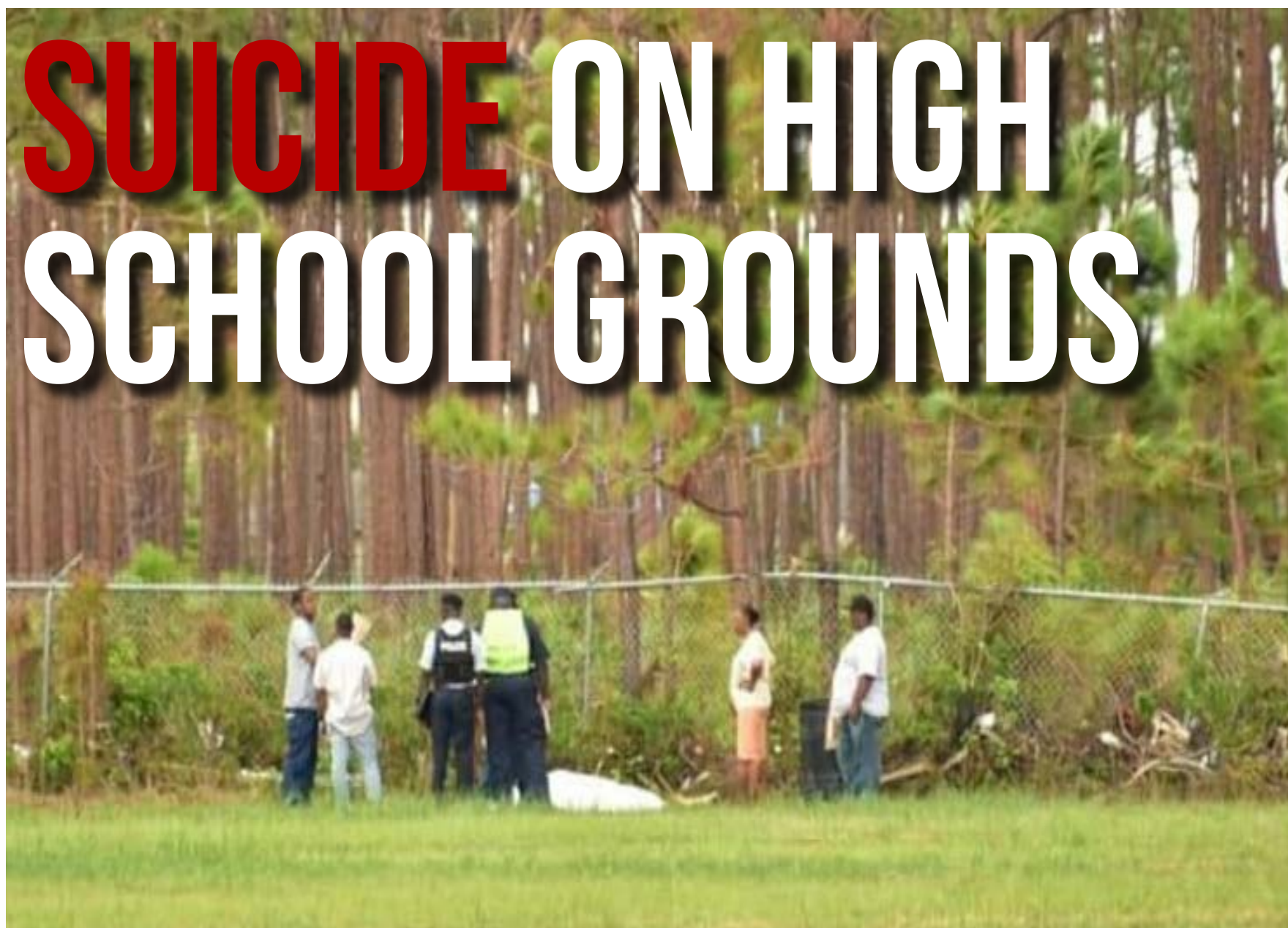

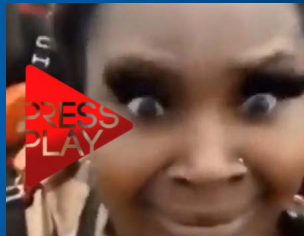
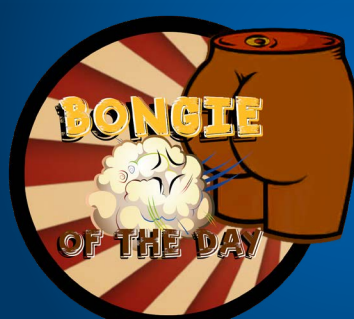

The scene is a classic and everyone sat on the edge of their seats waiting for it. What happens when there is a shark attack on land and no one is there to warn you? Such attacks have been occurring for decades and there has been very little resolve or satisfaction for thousands of people who were bamboozled and swindled out of thousands of dollars invested in property ownership. Below is a complaint logged by a BN agent. It reads as follows:

“I need for you to post this for me. Land Sharks, be warned. I would like to let the public know if you are purchasing any property from anyone please do your research before handing over your money. Go to the Registrar General’s

Office to see if this individual acquire such said property and to the Supreme Court.

Some land sharks surveyors have stolen other people’s property and sold it off because they are surveyors and some others worked for Land and Survey Department who have committed fraud on crown land by falsifying documents to make it look like they own the property.

Here are some names you need to pay close attention if you bought property from, these people they are selling you stolen property. G.W. MURDER #90 - 16 YEAR OLD MURDERED

Identity of the young male that was shot and killed Thursday afternoon in the Gamble Heights area has been revealed.

Romeo Lynes Jr just 16-years-old is the country's 90th homicide victim. Around 3:00pm October 12th 2019, in the Gamble Heights community off Baillou Hill Road.

He was gunned down suffering a fatal gunshot injury to the head.

His father the late Romeo Lynes Sr was shot dead similarly back in 2016.

Police must speak to this level of gun violence now engulfing the Bahamas since Hurricane Dorian. Some 6 persons were murdered last week and for the record some 11 persons shot!

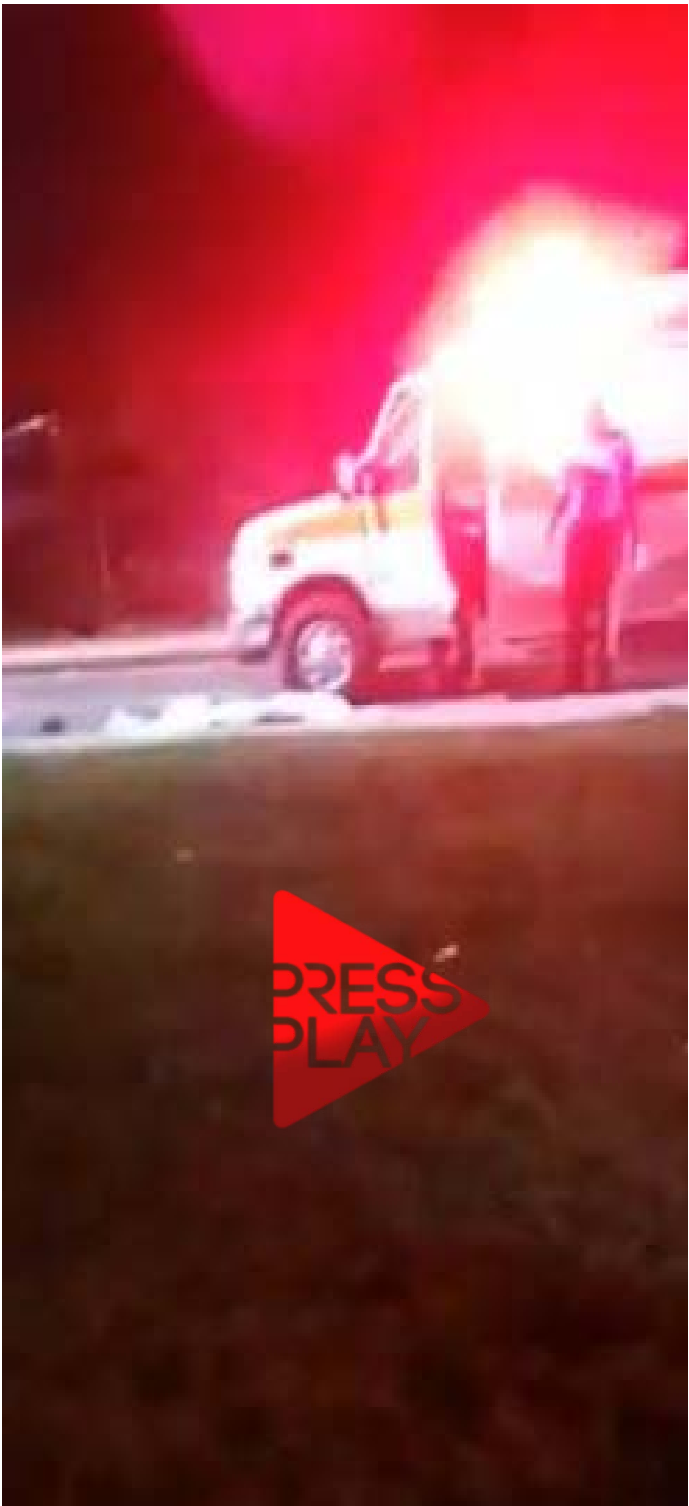

On Saturday the Broadcasting Corporation of the Bahamas lost one of its dedicated employees. Maintenance Department employee at the BCB, Fred Ferguson, had succumbed in a Florida hospital where he was receiving treatment following a vehicular accident.

You would recall how, back

on April 23, 2019, Archie Cambridge, a cameraman at Bahamas Information Services, Fred Ferguson and Lenard Saunders, both employees at the BCB, all had to be rushed to hospital just after leaving the funeral services for the late Colin Trotman that was held at BFM.

The bad mishap occurred on the slippery wet Milo Butler Highway that afternoon. Ferguson, who initially was admitted into

Doctor's Hospital, was later airlifted into Florida where he underwent treatment. He passed away on Saturday.

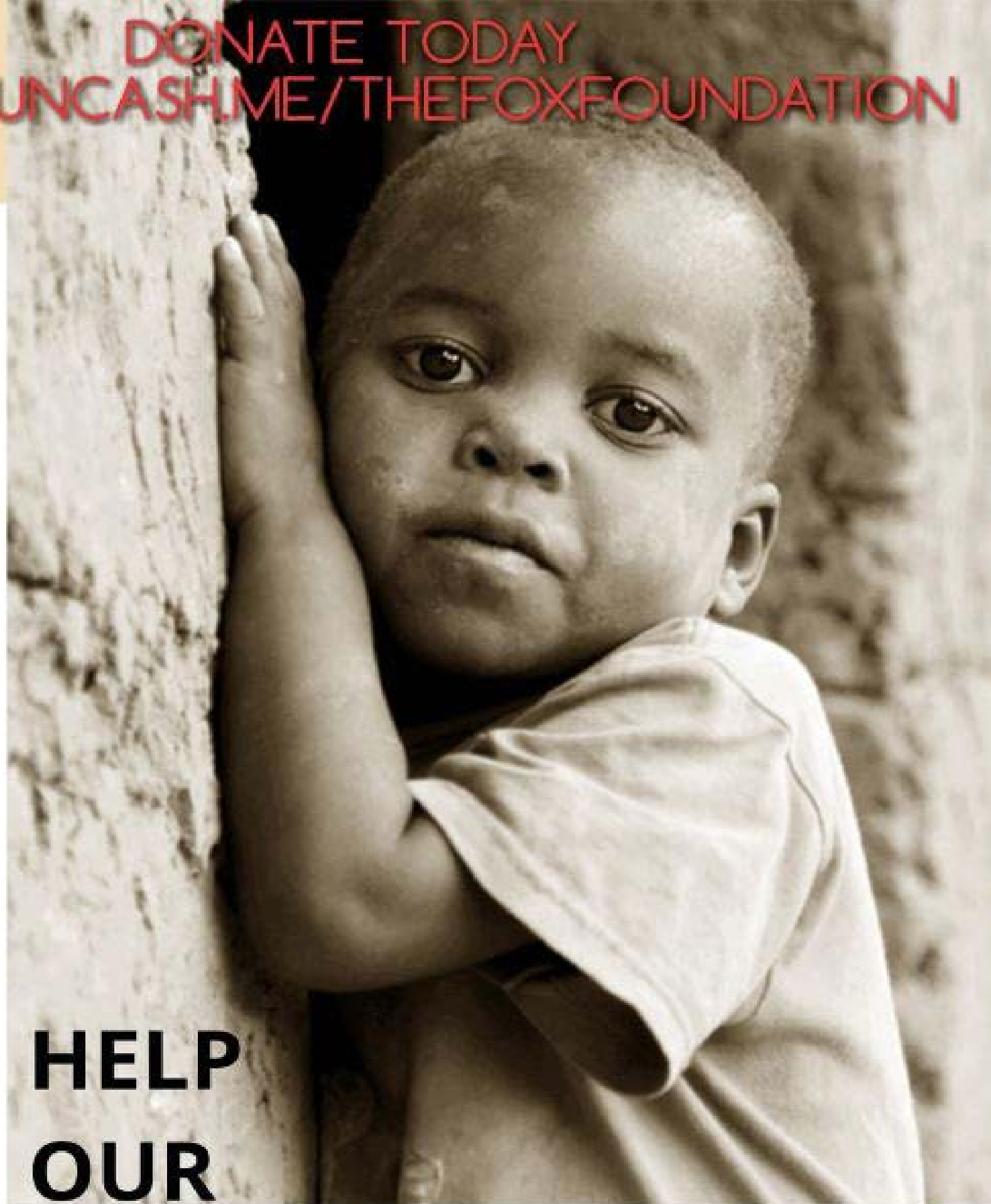
