



WHAT'S INNOVATIVE ABOUT US?

- 1. useit brings together many different **CATEGORIES OF ASSETS** onto one single platform: there is no need to navigate on differentiated or specialized websites when advertising or searching for something.
- 2. u-coins are the **VIRTUAL CURRENCY** used on the platform for regulating, monitoring and protecting transactions between users: it is thus possible to participate **safely** without ever needing to put your hand to your wallet.
- 3. **NO COMMISSION** is charged on any of the rental transactions.
- 4. safety net: useit's **FREE INSURANCE** mechanism will increase **up to 2,000 euros** for each user and cover potential material damages to property in accordance with commendable user behaviour (this is monitored via the user-feedback system), also users may also request a discretionary deposit to protect their shared goods.
