

Clays Shoot - Summer Picnic – Water Retrieve

Shooting: Black Dog Clays 7680 W. Vallejo Road Boise, Idaho

Water Event & Picnic: Christian Children's Ranch 2421 W. Duck Alley Road Eagle, Idaho

Get your favorite shotgun and load up your hunting dogs it's time for the Club's annual Summer Picnic, Sporting Clays Competition and Water Retrieve! Check out the Club's web site for the history of the event www.gspcidaho.org.

Shooting Start time: 9:00am, Saturday, June 23, 2018

Where: Black Dog Clays

Directions: From the Boise area take the S Cole Rd exit off of I-84 and proceed south on S Cole Rd for approximately 4.5 miles to W. Vallejo Rd and turn right and proceed .4 miles to location.

Picnic Start time: 12.00pm, Saturday, June 23, 2018

Where: Christian Children's Ranch 2421 W. Duck Alley Road Eagle, Idaho

Directions: From the Black Dog Clays go east on W. Vallejo Rd to S. Cole Rd and turn left. Proceed north on S. Cole Rd 4.7 miles and merge onto I-84 W/US-30 W via the ramp on the left toward Nampa/City Center. Proceed 3.7 miles to the Eagle Rd exit and merge onto Eagle Rd. Proceed 5 miles on Eagle Rd to Chinden Blvd/US 20/26. Turn left and proceed on Chinden Blvd/US 20/26 for 3 miles to N. Linder Rd. Turn right on N. Linder Rd and proceed .7 miles to W. Duck Alley Rd. Turn left on W. Duck Alley Rd and proceed approximately 1 mile to event location. Watch for club signs.

Miscellaneous: The area around the pond has changed and it is basically bare ground with little shade. Therefore it is a good idea to bring something to give you and your dog or at least your dog some shade. Most of the food and water/pop for the picnic will be provided by the Club, but it's requested that individuals bring a dessert to share.

Derby - (to 24 months) \$10 entry fee

Make one (1) 10 yard retrieve, and one (1) 20 yard retrieve. Retrieve must be within three (3) large steps by the handler. Handler can move backwards to assist in bird delivery.

Gun Dog – (any age Dogs do not have to be broke) \$15 entry fee

Make one (1) 20 yard retrieve, followed by a sighted "double" consisting of a short 10 yard retrieve and a longer 20 yard retrieve. Handler cannot move forward or backward to complete the retrieve, and retrieves must be within two (2) large steps of the handler to qualify. Hard mouth would be penalized.

Broke Dog – (any age) \$15 entry fee

Make one (1) 20 yard single retrieve, followed by a "double" consisting of one 20 yarder followed by a 'blind' 30 yarder. Qualifying dogs on this stake must be absolutely steady-to-wing-and-shot, and must absolutely deliver to hand while handler is stationary (no handler movements, forward or backward). Hard mouth would be severely penalized. Hand signals and thrown objects are allowed to guide the dogs on the "blind" retrieve.
